The objective of the Association is to complete an eight race series if at all possible.

The Farr 9.2 Association Race committee will consist of three Committee persons available on the day of racing including the President, Vice President, Handicapper or Secretary.

Sailing Instructions

.

- 1 The Races will be governed by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc., these sailing instructions, and the Farr 9.2 Class rules.
- 2 Races will be conducted under the Sailing Instructions of the various host Yacht Clubs
- 3 Scoring
 - 3.1 The championship scoring shall be in accordance with the low point scoring system in the RRS Appendix A
 - 3.2 Eight races are scheduled. Two or more races must be completed and count for the Series to be considered valid.
 - 3.3 When seven or eight races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores, changing rule appendix A2. If six or five races are completed only one race result will be dropped. If four or fewer races are completed no race results will be dropped.
 - 3.4 Boats' starting handicaps will be the last season's championship carried over from the results of the final race in last season's metro series. New boats will be assigned a handicap equal to that of the last season's championship winner. Handicaps will be recalculated after each race in the series.
 - 3.5 Championship first-, second- and third-place winners will be decided by the over-the-line points from the series. Consistency winners will be decided by the handicap points from the series, after excluding the three place winners from the championship results.

4 Replacement of Equipment

Boats will commit to their first hoisted spinnaker for the total duration of the individual race, with a substitution to a second spinnaker only in the event of a breakage of the first spinnaker. Post-Race verification and approval of damage must be obtained from the Farr9.2 Race Committee or/and State measurer.
